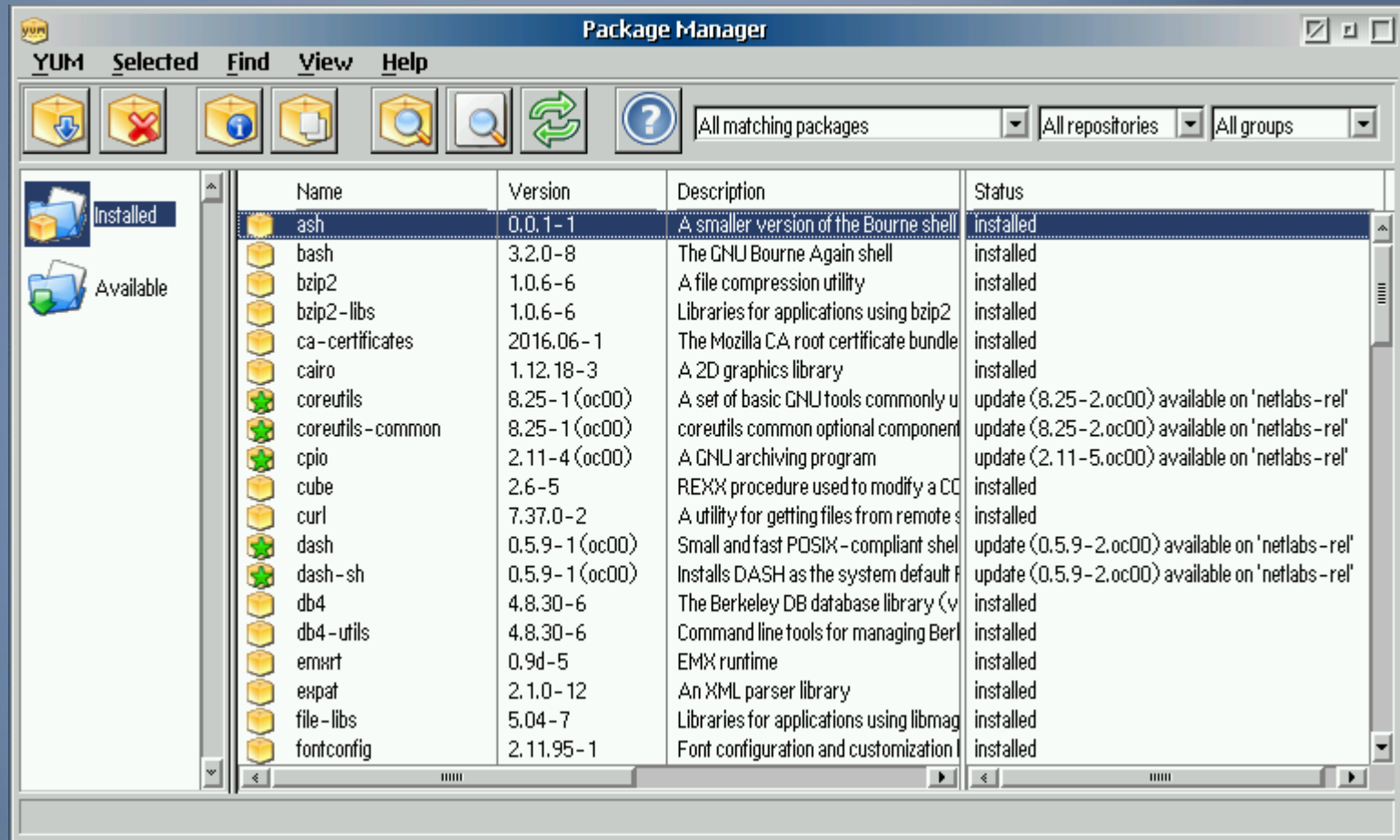
What is ANPM?

Arca Noae Package Manager (ANPM) is a graphical software manager for OS/2.

It is intended to reduce the pain of installing, removing, and/or updating software, managing dependencies, and minimizing conflicts.



The Arca Noae Package Manager



Why ANPM?

- OS/2 software is increasingly distributed and managed using two incompatible systems: WarpIN and RPM/YUM.
- Changing from one to the other can lead to ‘DLL hell’ and other dependency conflicts.
- RPM/YUM is opaque and awkward to use.



What ANPM Does Now

- Easy-to-use front-end to most common YUM operations.
- Simple YUM repository manager.
- Support for 'secure' YUM repositories.
- Detection of DLL and EXE conflicts.
- Graphical RPM and WPI package inspector.



Planned Features

- Platform (architecture) configuration.
- Import/export package lists.
- WarpIN (WPI) package management and repository support.
- Plugin configuration.
- Package replacement (including platform swapping).
- UI improvements.
